Children in Need Day - Friday 16th November

We would like to raise funds for this year's Children in Need appeal, and feel that the best and easiest way for all our children to be involved is to have a dress down day. Therefore, Friday 16th November will be a non-uniform day, and if you wish to make a donation to the appeal, please send it in on Friday with your child (suggested donation £1). All contributions will be passed on the Charity.

Flu Immunisations - Wednesday 21st November

Children in EYFS through to, and including, Year 5 will be offered a Flu immunisation next Wednesday, all details were sent by Parentmail last month - if you have not accessed the Immunisation team's dedicated site to confirm whether or not you wish for your child to take part in this year's immunisation scheme, please do so as soon as possible. If you have not received the email with all the information, and have a child in years EYFS to Yr5, please contact the school main office as soon as possible.

If you do not require your child to have the Flu immunisation, you should still log onto their website to decline the service - this will ensure that you do not receive follow-up/chase up communications from them.

Friday 23rd November - Non Pupil Day

Don't forget that next Friday is a non-pupil day, children are not required to be in school. Staff will be taking part in training sessions all day.

Medication in School

Please remember that children should not carry/keep any form of medication in their school bags/lockers. If your child requires medication within the school day and you wish for a member of staff to administer it, please speak to a member of the office team for further information BEFORE sending medication in as the relevant medication instructions MUST be completed before a member of staff can administer on your behalf.

Generally, we will only administer prescription medication, when required four or more times a day, but we are happy to answer any questions for further verification.

Remembrance Day

We are very pleased and proud of our Year 5 & 6 children, who took part in a special Remembrance Service at the church last Thursday. The children were thoughtful, showed respect and asked/answered lots of questions in a chat with members of the clergy.
