- As teachers are released to plan on different days of the week, not all weeks start on a Monday. Some will run from Wednesday to Wednesday for example.
- Where possible the previous week's learning will remain on the website for a few days in order for children to catch up if they have missed something out, or if it is more convenient for families to work on a different day to the scheduled one.
- As you know, children receive a list of tasks set as 2dos on Purple Mash. To avoid long lists of activities accumulating tasks will be closed 2 days after the day in which tasks were to be handed in. Keeping on track and on top of the daily tasks is important to prevent a build-up of incomplete work.
- Children at school are accessing the same learning and teachers need to keep the pace of teaching and feedback on going for all children.
- There is no expectation for children to complete tasks if they are unwell. If your child is at home and unwell please email the class teacher as this will explain why work has not be completed and will avoid an unnecessary phone call home.
- As learning is planned sequentially, if your child is unwell and not able to complete the work set within the 2 day window, but needs to access previous texts and activities in order to complete the most up to date work; please email the class teacher at the class address. This will allow teachers to respond individually to each request and re set tasks accordingly.
- Please don't feel you have to print and use lots of ink. There is no need to print off worksheets, use the screen as a textbook, complete tasks on paper and send back via SeeSaw, or in the case of EYFS Tapestry.
